REMINDER - Premier League Clubs Youth Programme for 2018 Club Licensing Criteria

Dear Secretaries

This is a reminder that the 2018 Club Licensing process will commence on September 01st, 2017 and conclude on November 03, 2017.

You are also reminded that one of the criteria for 2017 included the submission of a youth development programme plan for implementation in 2018.

The 2018 requirements stipulate that evidence must be shown that the Club does indeed have a youth development programme in place by the deadline date November 03rd 2017.

This evidence will be in the form of a document signed by the club President specifying the structure of the programme, amount of players as well as with signed BFA consent forms for each player, for a minimum of 20 players.

Premier League Clubs who have an existing youth programme and have participated in our youth competition in 2017 need not submit consent forms but will be required to submit the signed document specified above.

As an option, clubs may adopt schools to form their youth programme. In this case a signed agreement with the school must be submitted along with the signed consent forms for all the players. These players must be registered under the name of the club.
