PURCHASE OF TOKENS FOR USAGE AT NSC VENUES

Dear Members

The BFA was invited to a meeting today with the National Sports Council's Chairman and his representatives and efforts were made to ensure that teams could resume use of the lighting facilities at the venues islandwide. While there still is not a total resolution to the token issue, a decision was made to distribute some tokens to the BFA for their members.

Please note the following guidelines:

1. Tokens sold by the BFA will be sold only to member clubs.
2. BFA member clubs can only now purchase tokens from the BFA office and not from the NSC or other persons.
3. Preference for the moment will be on the Premier League clubs for training and the Division One clubs which will begin their competition on Wednesday November 14th, 2018, meaning, tokens will only be sold at the moment to these clubs.
4. A maximum amount of 6 tokens will be sold to each club at any given time.
5. Clubs are to identify two persons who will be responsible for purchasing the tokens on their behalf. A key for the token box will be issued by the NSC for these persons to access to the token box on behalf of football.
6. These persons will sign a liability form issued by the BFA and this information will be passed on to the NSC for their records.
7. Under no circumstances are the keys to be passed onto to other persons or are tokens to be sold to other clubs.
8. The BFA will send a weekly list of the tokens sold and to whom they were sold, to the NSC in-order for them to monitor usage and to identify any misuse.

The Chairman of the NSC is adamant that there will be no tolerance to fraudulent behaviour with regards to its equipment and has asked that this be emphasized to members.

Division two and three clubs will be notified of when they can purchase tokens.
