FOR YOUR ATTENTION REGARDING THE PREMIER LEAGUE

Dear Members,

We draw to your attention some issues that have arisen which are affecting the Premier League competition.

1. Children in the players and officials' area

Absolutely no children are allowed in the players and officials area. Security has been advised not to allow this. Persons are advised to make the necessary arrangements prior to gameday to avoid disappointment at the door.

2. Team List for Game Day

Clubs are still being delinquent in submitting their 20 players for matchday. As a consequence, we are now requesting that the team list be submitted by **Thursday 4.00 p.m. prior for games on Saturday and Sunday**. For games on **Tuesdays** the list should be submitted by **Monday 10.00 a.m. prior** and for games on **Thursdays** the list should be submitted by **Tuesday 4.00 p.m. prior**. Clubs are asked to comply to avoid any need for disciplinary enforcement.

3. Starting List

The managers or coaches are asked to submit their starting eleven on arrival at the venue. This is to give the BFA enough time to prepare the documents necessary for the media and referees. **The latest this should be delivered is 20 minutes prior to the start of the game.** Again, clubs are asked to comply to avoid any need for disciplinary enforcement.

4. Medical Personnel

It has been brought to our attention that some teams may have been turning up to games without a qualified medic. Be reminded that as part of the club licensing process this is a requirement. The EMT personnel provided by the BFA are for instances where there is serious injury, requiring advance attention. **The BFA will take disciplinary action against any club which is in breach of this rule.**
